## **NEW EPA CERTIFIED RENOVATOR LEAD SAFETY FOR RENOVATION, REPAIR AND PAINTING**

*Learn How to be in Compliance!*

### **SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE CERTIFIED RENOVATORS TRAINING PROGRAM ALLOWS:**

- You to become a Certified Renovator
- You or your employer to become a Certified Firm with the EPA as required before October 1, 2010
- You to receive 8 hours of continuing education credits approved from the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry (The course does NOT include Building Energy)

### **OBJECTIVES:**

- Why should I be concerned about lead paint?
- EPA/HUD Regulations
- Before beginning work
- During work
- Cleaning activities and checking your work
- Recordkeeping
- Training non-certified workers
- State specific regulations/rules

### **THIS REGULATION APPLIES:**

If you work (for compensation) on pre-1978 residential properties, child care facilities or schools.

If you disturb 6 sq. ft. of known or assumed lead-based paint inside or 20 sq. ft. outside.

If you are a general contractor, painter, renovator, electrician, handyman/woman, specialty contractor, or maintenance person at schools or multi-housing complexes.

### **ABOUT THE PRESENTERS:**

Midwest Environmental Consulting L.L.C. (MEC) staff has been providing adult-education for twenty years. MEC staff has been providing lead specific training programs since 1993 when the federal rule known as Title X was executed. MEC staff has "in the field" and "hands on" experience providing lead-based paint inspections, lead risk assessments, lead abatement supervision and lead project design services which the other currently licensed/certified training providers may not have.

Let MEC's staff provide not only information on regulatory requirements but also on real in-the-field knowledge on projects and help guide you and your employees to be more professional about lead hazard reduction activities and lead safe work procedures.

While lead hazard reduction activities have been used since the late 1980's new technology has found that even low levels of exposure may lead to adverse health affects. This training will help your organization understand the growing information on lead hazards and the ever evolving rules that govern lead hazard reduction.

### **TARGET AUDIENCE:**

Companies that will be required to be Certified Firms and have trained individuals for working in a lead safe manner include but are not limited to: licensed general contractors and remodelers, specialty contractors such as mechanical, heating, venting and air conditioning contractors, plumbers, electricians, painters, siding contractors, fire and restoration companies, and maintenance staff at schools, child-care facilities and residential rental properties.

### **PURPOSE:**

This EPA/HUD joint course trains individuals on how to become Certified Lead-Based Paint Renovators with proper lead safe work practices.

**IMPORTANT TO NOTE:** US EPA has delayed enforcement of the Renovation, Repair and Painting Rule's firm certification requirement until October 1, 2010. This delay was made to accommodate contractors who have not been able to find or take a Certified Training Provider course. EPA will not enforce against individual renovation workers if the person has applied to enroll in, or has enrolled in, by no later than September 30, 2010, an approved Certified Renovator course from an approved training provider. This course must be taken by December 31, 2010. All other provisions of the rule are still enforceable.
